***AIB'S AFTERNOON SUMMER LINEUP NOW INCLUDES  
PROGRAMMING FOR DEAF CHILDREN***

Atlanta Interfaith Broadcasters, Atlanta, GA - *Dr. Wonder's Workshop*, performed by an all deaf cast, will air on AIB Monday thru Friday at 4:00 pm beginning June 23. This innovative weekly television series provides thirty minutes of fun for deaf and hearing children of all ages. All characters speak in ASL – American Sign Language. (An audio track of voiceovers, sound effects and music is added for the enjoyment of hearing children.) Each show features a humorous episode with a cast of zany characters, who work in the research lab of an inventor named Dr. Wonder. There they learn how to apply scripture principles of living to their relationships with one another.

Immediately following *Dr. Wonder's Workshop* at 4:30 pm is AIB's Original Series *Sound of Youth*. The Emmy nominated *Sound of Youth* is thought-provoking programming that creates a comfortable environment for teens from all communities to express their thoughts on topics like spirituality, music, school and dating. Teen hosts from all faiths bring a cool array of cultural flavors to the show. Whether you're a teen or the parent of one, you'll gain plenty of insight on what continues to impact the lives of teenagers.

AIB provides educational, fun children's & youth programming weekdays from 3:00 – 5:00 pm. It begins with *Groundling Marsh*, a magical wetland inhabited by eccentric puppet characters. Each episode contains songs, animated segments and adventures. *Groundling Marsh* is followed by *Ruffus The Dog* and then *Panda Bear Daycare*. *Ruffus The Dog* lives in a funky old bookshop and puts his own unique spin on classic fairytales and folktales. *Panda Bear Daycare* shares famous Panda Poetry with five pre-schoolers as they learn important life lessons.
