***ATLANTA INTERFAITH BROADCASTERS RECEIVES EMMY
NOMINATION FOR WORLD PILGRIM: A SACRED JOURNEY
TO TURKEY***

Atlanta Interfaith Broadcasters, Atlanta, GA, May 14, 2008 - AIB has been nominated for an Emmy in Outstanding Achievement for Television Programming Excellence by the Southeast Regional Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences. The Emmy nomination is for the 2007 documentary ***World Pilgrims: A Sacred Journey to Turkey, Part 1 & 2***. Winners will be announced June 21, 2008 at the 2008 Southeast Regional Emmy Awards.

World Pilgrims documents the spiritual and personal journey of 33 metro Atlantans from Jewish, Christian and Muslim faiths. This documentary spotlights the appreciation of the shared elements of three faith traditions as a greater understanding and respect of differences emerges.

This is AIB's second Emmy Nomination. AIB's original series ***Sound of Youth*** received a nomination for Excellence in Children/Youth Programming in 2006.
